### Carpenter's House for Children

Over the years, Pat and Linda Manfredi of the Carpenter's House in Leesburg have cared for international children. These children have been abandoned or displaced through no fault of their own. The Carpenter's House operates through a loose affiliation of Christian organizations that operate among the unpredictable Haitian society to give homes to these children. The Clyde F. Green Foundation supplements financial aid to allow these children to experience a private education in an environment which meets each child's individual needs.

Son of Joe Caggiano and Cindi Heiligenthal, Joey, a junior at Mt. Dora High School, has been raised in the Golden Triangle area. As a result of premature birth, Joey has



cerebral palsy. He also suffers from scoliosis and is bound to a wheelchair. Joey and his family have partnered with the Foundation to raise the funds to install a new lift system in his father's house to assist

Joey in his daily living activities. The Foundation is also raising funds for specialized private driving lessons for Joey.

### Amber Poplick

Amber, daughter of Jo Bellow-Vorobyeva, was diagnosed with cerebral palsy shortly after birth. Two years ago, the Clyde F. Green Foundation helped Jo purchase a new specially-equipped van which provides transportation from home to special education school and other places as needed and is continuing to help provide Amber with special services that will allow her to live to the best of her abilities.
